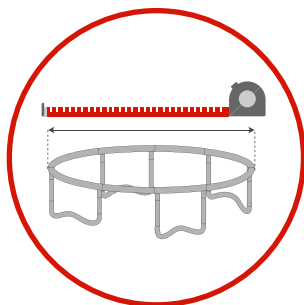


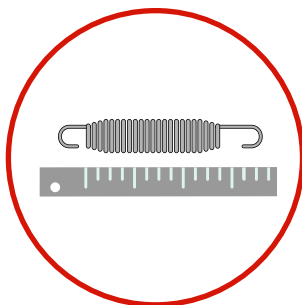
"How To" Guide

IDENTIFY THE SIZE AND MODEL YOUR TRAMPOLINE

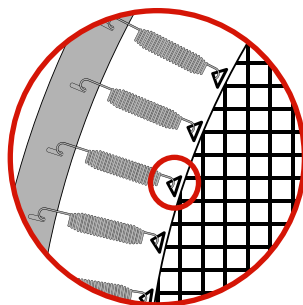
Following 3 simple steps will make it easier to find spare parts that will fit.



Measure the frame



Measure a spring



Count the spring attachments

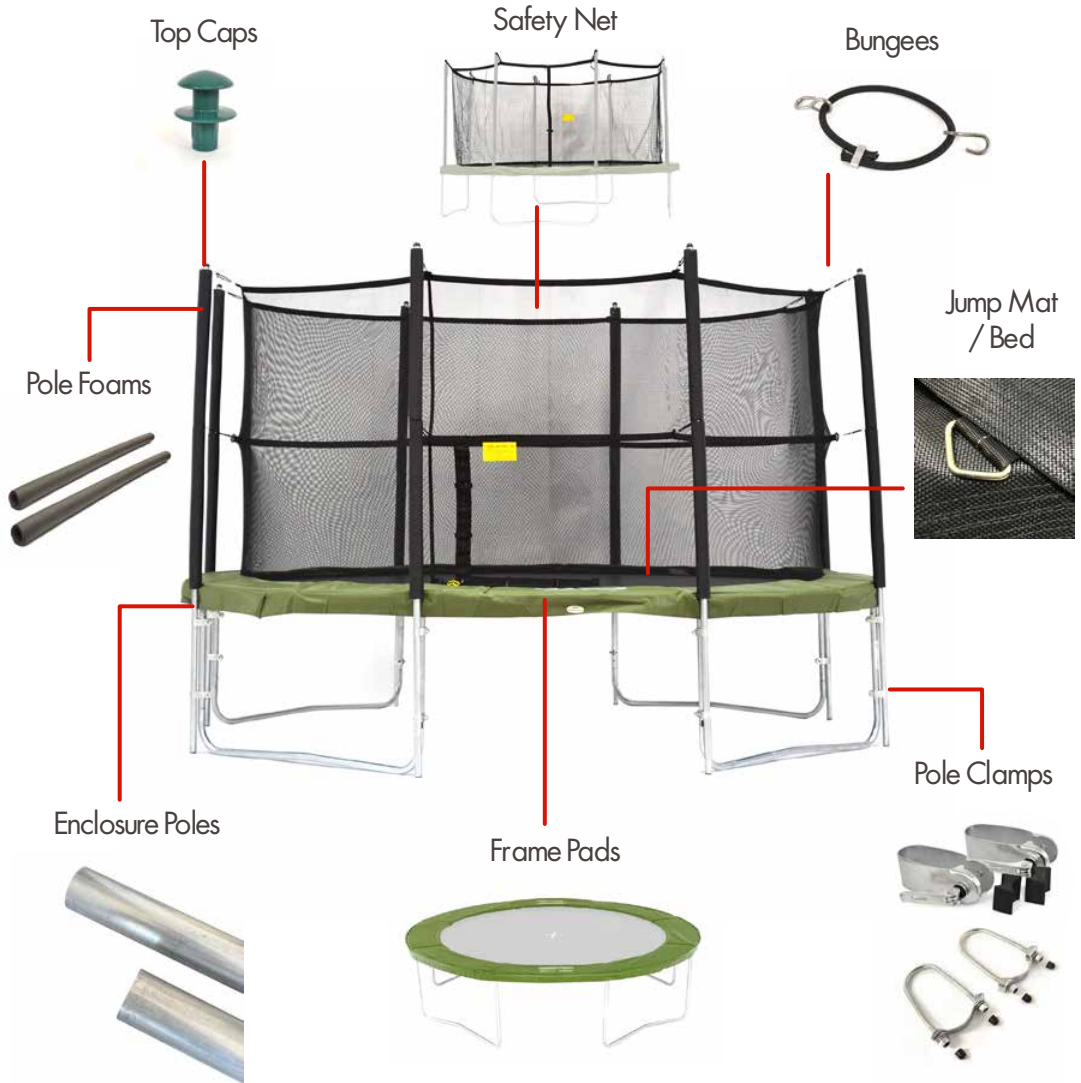

Trampoline Glossary of Terms

Easily find what you are looking for by searching for these common spare parts.



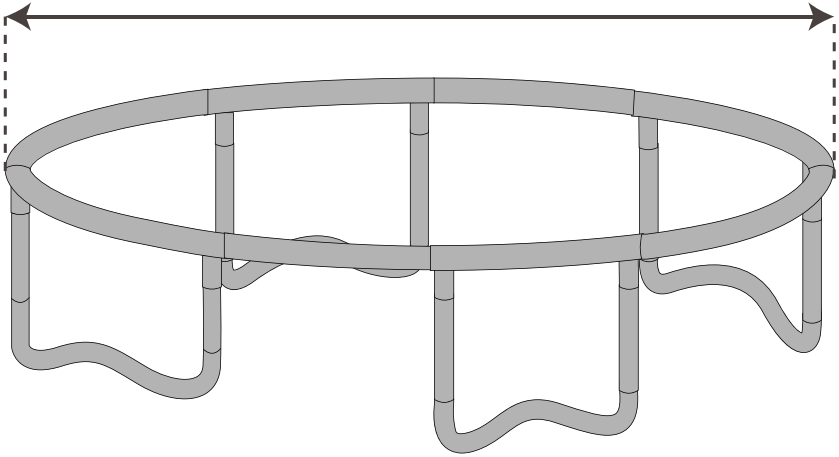
Find out the size and model of your ROUND garden trampoline

Round Trampoline are typically manufactured in 4 standard sizes: 8ft, 10ft, 12ft and 14ft.

Follow the 3 steps below and with your measurements, refer to the table on the next page to identify the size and model of your Super Tramp Trampoline.

Step 1.

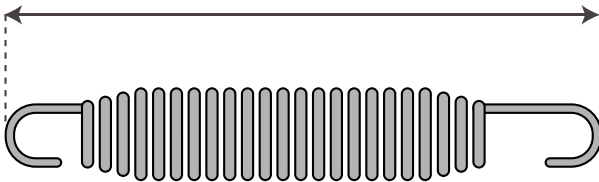
Measure outer frame edge to outer frame edge. Note down the measurements (in feet and inches)



Step 2.

Carefully remove a spring. Measure your spring from hook to hook (in inches).

Note; your spring will have stretched slightly due to use. Round down your measurement to match it to the nearest standard size.



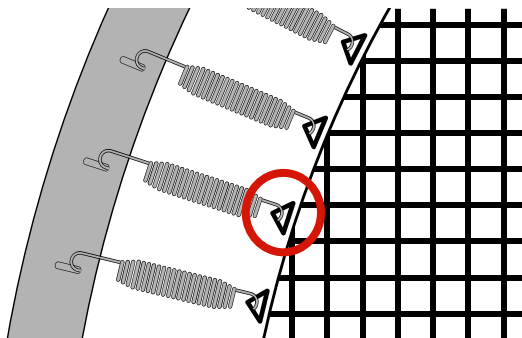
Standard spring sizes: 5.5 inch, 7 inch, 8.35 inch, 8.5 inch, 8.57 inch and 9.25 inch

Step 3.

Look at your trampoline bed / jump mat.

Using a place holder, work your way around the bed counting the total number of spring attachments.

These are typically small metal or plastic triangles.

Using your data, refer to the below table to identify your trampoline

Frame diameter (feet)	Length of spring (inches)	No. of spring attachments	Your measurements suggest your trampoline is:
8'	5.5 inch	48.00	→ 8ft Round with 5.5 inch spring
8'	7 inch	48.00	→ 8ft Round with 7 inch spring
10'	5.5 inch	54.00	→ 10ft Superflyer MK3, Eclipse, Springtime (2014-2019)
9' 8"	7 inch	72.00	→ 9ft 8 inch Cosmic Bouncer pre 2009
10'	5.5 inch	60.00	→ 10ft with 5.5inch springs
10'	7 inch	54.00	→ 10ft with 7inch springs
10'	7 inch	64.00	→ 10ft with 7inch springs PLUS
10'	7 inch	72.00	→ 10ft Cosmic Bouncer 2014 - onwards
11' 9"	8.5 inch	80.00	→ 11ft 9in Fun Bouncer pre 2009,
12'	7 inch	72.00	→ 12ft Superflyer MK3, Eclipse, Springtime (2014-2019)
12'	8.5 inch	80.00	→ 12ft Fun Bouncer 2009 - onwards and Vault
12'	8.5 inch	88.00	→ 12ft round with 8.5 inch spring
14'	7 inch	80.00	→ 14ft Superflyer MK3, Eclipse, Springtime (2014-2019)
14'	7 inch	88	→ 14ft with 7inch spring PLUS
14'	8.5 inch	96	→ 14ft Super bouncer, Vault

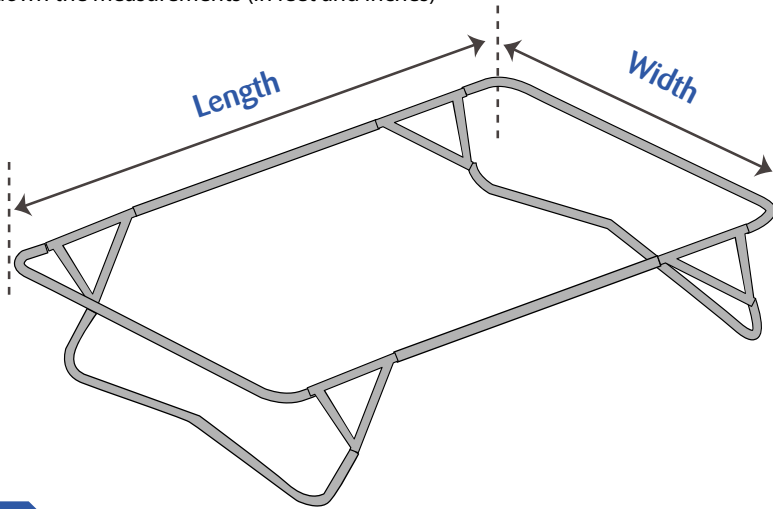
Find out the size and model of your RECTANGULAR garden trampoline

Rectangular Trampolines vary in size. Measure the long side then the short side of the frame.

Follow the 3 steps below and with your measurements, refer to the table on the next page to identify the size and model of your Super Tramp Trampoline.

Step 1.

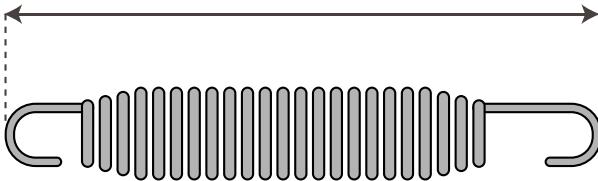
Measure the length and width of your trampoline frame.
Note down the measurements (in feet and inches)



Step 2.

Carefully remove a spring. Measure your spring from hook to hook (in inches).

Note; your spring will have stretched slightly due to use. Round down your measurement to match it to the nearest standard size.



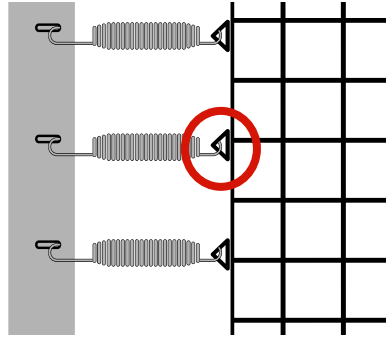
Standard spring sizes: 5.5 inch, 7 inch, 8.35 inch, 8.5 inch, 8.57 inch and 9.25 inch

Step 3.

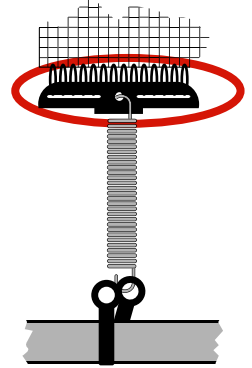
Look at your trampoline bed / jump mat.

Using a place holder, work your way around the bed counting the total number of spring attachments.

These are typically small metal or plastic triangles, or in the case of a 2-string bed plastic fixings.

Using your data, refer to the below table to identify your trampoline

Frame dimensions - length and width (feet and inches)	Length of spring (inches)	No. of spring attachments	Your measurements suggest your trampoline is:
10' x 6"	7 inch	52.00	→ Action 17 (garden trampoline)
16' 11" x 9' 10"	9.25 inch	118.00	→ Boomer
7' 7" x 5' 3"	5.5 inch	36.00	→ Frog
14' 5" x 8' 3"	8.35 inch	100.00	→ Kangaroo or Super Kangaroo
10' 11" x 8' 4"	8.5 inch	74.00	→ King
11' 8" x 10'	7 inch	56.00	→ Prince
10' 1" x 5' 9"	7 inch	50.00	→ Senior 15
12' 5" x 8' 3"	8.57 inch	74.00	→ Wallaby
12' 5" x 8' 3"	8.57 inch	86.00	→ Wallaby with 2 string bed
10' x 7'	7 inch	68.00	→ XR300
12' x 8'	8.5 inch	84.00	→ XR360
